



Mentorship Guidelines

1. Spend Time Together:

- Plan to meet with your student mentee at least once a month for a full calendar year.
- *Quality* time is more important than *quantity* of time.
- These meetings can be fun activity outings, coffeeshop conversations, inviting them over for dinner with your family, etc.

2. Read Scripture and Pray Together:

- Have Bible-based and Christ-centered conversations.
- Model the Christian life for your student. Show how your relationship with Christ shapes your life as an adult. Share with them what you're learning, and teach them how to be a follower of Christ.
- Ask your student mentee how you can pray for them, and spend significant, intentional time doing so.

3. Ask Questions.

- Don't do all the talking... do all of the listening!
- Prepare thoughtful questions beforehand.
- Show your student you are genuinely interested in their life and are a safe space for them to open up.
